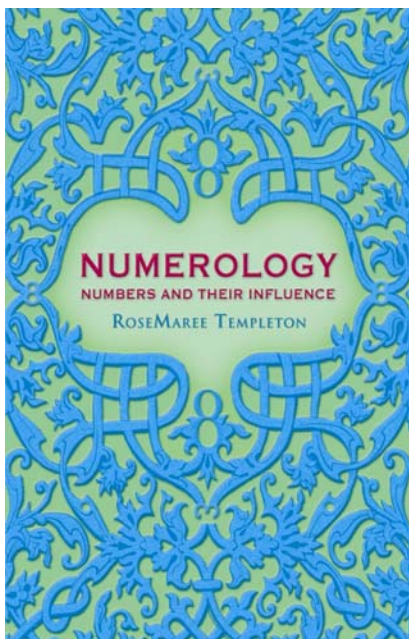


NUMEROLOGY Numbers and their influence by RoseMaree Templeton

Author RoseMaree Templeton began her lifelong journey with numerology in her teens, studying under her grandmother, Hettie Templeton, Australia's foremost numerologist during the 1940s and 1950s.

Hettie was highly sought after as an advisor and teacher and had her own talk-back program on Radio 2GB in Sydney. She realised her methods were unorthodox but she loved the Science and symbolic relevance of numbers and the work of the Greek philosopher Pythagoras.

Her claim was that a correct understanding of the law of numbers would reveal the general characteristics of any person. Her greatest wish was for parents to know the inner natures of their children and to understand the differences between them.

RoseMaree combines Hettie's teachings with her own insights and experiences. The result is this book – a return to the basics of self-help numerology.

The author has a charm and wisdom that, like her grandmother, she enjoys sharing and has guided many in making decisions about career, relationships, travel and even real estate. RoseMaree has also modified lessons for distance learning of numerology, held workshops, lectures and done countless readings.

This book will show you how to prepare readings for yourself, family and friends by:

- Calculating and interpreting your ruling number, day number and destiny number
 - Drawing up and reading birthdates and name charts
- Reading pyramid charts that map peaks and troughs throughout life

At the age of 17, she began to study the Science of Numbers learning about numerology as well as Pythagorean philosophy with her grandmother Hettie Templeton. She did her leaving certificate and worked in various jobs from a large real estate agency, to the publicity department at *Channel 9*, to *The NSW Police Department D.E.A (Drug Enforcement Agency)*. After the death of her grandmother, RoseMaree spent two years in Papua New Guinea, where she had many varied experiences, including meeting Prince Phillip and working at *The University of Papua New Guinea (UPNG)* and *The Boroko Hotel*. She has also traveled to India, China, Hong Kong, Macau, Philippines,

About Hettie Templeton (1887-1967)



Hettie Templeton was one of the first Australian numerologists and the first president of the Pythagorean Society in Australia. In 1940 she published *Numbers and their influence*, which she updated in 1956 with *A Philosophy of Numbers*. Her studies in this field began long before 1940 when she devised a simple four-line chart for birthdate numbers. She noticed that the charts had certain patterns, which she named ‘arrows’, and developed from this a line of research based on the ancient Greek mathematician and philosopher Pythagoras. As her knowledge and experience grew, so did her popularity as a teacher and advisor of numerology.
